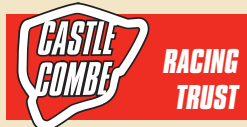
Administered by a board of trustees, the Trust's income is normally generated from collections, donations and legacies and the first significant and high-profile beneficiary grant was for the purchase of the Ford Ranger 4X4 fast-response fire vehicle that has become a regular feature in the Castle Combe pit lane. No fees or expenses are ever levied to the Trust's account, meaning that 100% of the cash raised is passed on to beneficiaries.

To date, the Trust has awarded over £18K and in addition to the Ford fire truck, other essential items purchased have included fire extinguishers and specialist medical equipment for the circuit's Peter Basket Medical Centre, including the latest state-of-the-art defibrillators. Among donations to worthy local causes, the Trust has made an award to the Wiltshire Air Ambulance, matched by a donation from the Castle Combe Circuit. The Trust is constantly seeking new and innovative sources of revenue as well as worthy motor racing causes.
