North Yorkshire

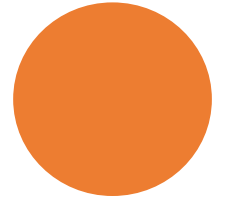
- My wife Jane and I live in Wharfedale on the north edge of Leeds, with our two over indulged cats.
